Workshop on “Plant water relations“ 8 – 9 May, 2017

Prof. Dr. D.A. Grantz, UC Riverside, USA & PD Dr. J. Burkhardt, Bonn

The workshop will address problems of plant gas exchange and hydraulics. It consists of a morning session (Monday 8th of May, a.m.) and a hands-on session with the use of actual instruments (8th of May, p.m. and/or 9th of May, a.m.).

Participants should have a basic knowledge of plant transpiration and gas exchange. The course is mainly meant for graduate students (MSc Plant Science, TBGS, ZEFc) and postdocs, but interested students are also welcome to attend.

Depending on the size of the group, the hands-on session (practical part) will be split into two smaller groups (May 8, p.m. and May 9 a.m.).

Prof. Grantz is a plant physiologist and air pollution effects specialist and was the Director of the Kearney Agricultural Center at Parlier, California. He has done pioneering work on the coordination of plant hydraulics and gas exchange. In 2016, he spent a sabbatical year in Bonn to work on aerosol effects on plant water relations: This topic is also the main scientific interest of Dr. Burkhardt.
